Text: Revelation 19:11-21

Topic: Judgment, Evil, Triumph

Big Idea of the Message: Though evil is real and powerful, in the end it will be

defeated forever through the power of Jesus Christ.

Applicational Point: We can persevere through evil and suffering by placing our hope

in Christ.

Film: Avengers: Infinity War (May 4, 2018)

Topic: Kingdom, Evangelism

Big Idea of the Message: The promise of the gospel is not for us to "escape" to heaven, but for God's Kingdom to come to earth through the power of Christ in us. **Applicational Point:** Instead of separating ourselves from the world around us with a

wall, we can be a bridge for the world to encounter the living God.

Big Idea of the Message: God is in control over all peoples, places, and things. **Application Point:** Rather than trying to get what you want all of the time, give God

control of your life.
