Week 1

Text: 1 Peter 1:1–9

Topic(s): Resurrection, Hope

Big Idea of the Message: Through the resurrection of Christ, we have a living hope, that sustains and strengthens the believer in all circumstances.

Application Point: We can live with hope, strength, and perseverance because of the power of the resurrection for the future and for today.

Discussion Questions:

1. Where have you placed your hope, instead of in God?
2. Knowing that everyone faces trials, can you remember times when you faced a difficulty and God seemed absent or intensely present? What made those times different?
3. What is one thing that seems hopeless? How can you trust the power of the resurrection to bring new life to that dead place?
4. Have you experienced a time when a trial tested your faith, but in hindsight you can see you received something “of greater worth than gold”? How can seeing God’s faithfulness help you persevere in your faith?
5. Is there anything else that stood out from the passage or study?
6. How can I pray for you?
