Week 1

Text: Ruth 1:1–22

Topic: Foreigners, Widows, Bereavement, Tragedy

Big Idea of the Message: The book of Ruth opens with tragedy upon tragedy. It appears that Naomi has been forgotten by God, but Ruth—a young, childless, foreign widow—shines as the book's godly example of perseverance.

Application Point: When God is silent in the midst of your suffering, trust him still.

- 1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
- 2. If you could describe the love of God from one word/phrase in Ruth 1, what would that word be?
- 3. Have you ever experienced God's "silence"? How did you grow, or what did you learn?
- 4. Can you relate more to Ruth's or Naomi's response to trauma?

Week 2

Text: Ruth 2:1–23

Topic: Marriage, Family, Love, Redemption

Big Idea of the Message: Yahweh's wings stretch over Ruth and Naomi in ways they could not have orchestrated.

Application Point: Trust that Yahweh's wings of refuge will cover you. Seek to be a refuge to those in need.

- 9. Is there a time in your life when you now realize God was covering you, though you couldn't recognize it at the time?

Week 3 Text: Ruth 3:1–18 Topic: Redeemer, Marriage, Courage, Trust, Honor, Loyal Love Big Idea of the Message: A love that is godly is a love that protects, provides, and inspires.

Application Point: Make sure your love honors—in the daylight or at night.

Week 4 Text: Ruth 4:1–22 Topic: Redemption, Provision, Protection, God's Love Big Idea of the Message: In God's kingdom, nobody makes a name for himself or herself by being selfish. Application Point: Give your life away for Jesus's sake.
