Week 1

Text: Colossians 1:9–14

Topics: Forgiveness, Sacrifice, Fully Atoned

Big Idea of the Message: In the atonement of Christ, forgiveness is provided fully for all who have sinned.

Application Point: We have the comfort of knowing we are fully forgiven in Christ's sacrifice.

Discussion Questions:

Week 2

Text: Matthew 6:11–12

Topics: Forgiveness, Freedom, Forgiving Others

Big Idea of the Message: God has freely forgiven us in Christ; we did not earn it. Because we have been forgiven, we can freely forgive others who have wronged us.

Application Point: We will freely forgive others; they don't have to earn it.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
2. What is your favorite thing you've gotten for free?
3. What does it mean when we say that God gives forgiveness freely?
4. What does Jesus tell us in the Lord's Prayer?
5. Why is it hard to forgive others?
6. How can we help one another forgive better?
7. How can we pray for you?



Week 3

Text: Hebrews 10:12–18

Topics: Forgiveness, Forever, Complete Atonement

Big Idea of the Message: God's forgiveness in Christ is complete. Nothing be added to it, and we can rest assured that forgiveness is provided forever.

Application Point: We will have peace through knowing our forgiveness has no expiration date.

Discussion Questions:
